### ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

#### Admission Requirements for Associate Degree, Certificate and Specialized Training Certificates within Degree Programs:

Students are enrolled on unconditional admission status if all admission requirements have been met and all required documents have been received or conditional admission status if additional documents are required.

- >> Admissions application
- Official high school transcript or Official GED certificate/scores and/or other college/university transcripts
- >> Proof of Alabama residency
- >> COMPASS Assessment
- >> Other documents (as required for specific programs)

#### Admission Requirements for Specialized Training Certificates within Non-Degree Programs:

Students who do not have a high school diploma or GED may be admitted to pursue this award, provided they meet the prerequisites below and all other admission requirements listed above.

- >> Must be at least 16 years of age
- Must not have been enrolled in secondary education for at least one calendar year
- >> Must pass the Ability-to-Benefit test for the college

#### Admission Requirements for International Students:

Prior to being issued an I-20 form, international students must present the following items to Trenholm State Technical College:

- >> An official translated copy of the student's high school transcript (and college transcript(s), if applicable);
- Official transcript showing a minimum of 500 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL);
- Signed, notarized statement declaring that they will be fully responsible for their financial obligations while attending college;
- >> Documentation demonstrating adequate health and life insurance which must be maintained during all periods of enrollment; and
- >> College application for admission.

Students from a country where English is the native language or students who have successfully completed a college-level English course may be exempt from the TOEFL requirement. A student who wishes to transfer from another college or university in the United States must submit a transfer clearance form/letter from the institution where the student was last enrolled.

#### Payment of Tuition and Fees:

Tuition and fees for a full-time student average between \$1,080.00 -\$1,620.00 per term. Payment is required at the time of registration. The cost of books and supplies is additional. The college accepts cash, VISA, and MasterCard (the person whose name appears on the credit card must be present to make payment). The class schedules of students who have not paid will be voided daily.

Tuition Rate: \$139.00 per credit hour

Online Tuition Rate: \$139.00 per credit hour

Out-of-State Rate: 2.0 times that of In-State tuition rate.

#### Financial Aid Application Process:

To apply for financial aid, the applicant must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit it to the Central Processor. The FAFSA form is available either on line at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> from local high school counselors, public libraries or the Office of Financial Aid on either campus. **The College's Federal School Code is 005734**.

If you are eligible to receive student financial aid, you must have completed an Admissions Application and have in the Office of Admissions and Records either an official high school or GED transcript. Additionally, official transcripts from previously attended postsecondary institutions must be on file in the Office of Admissions and Records prior to the semester in which you enroll.

#### **COMPASS** Assessment:

First time college students are required to take the COMPASS Assessment. The COMPASS Assessment is designed to ensure proper course placement in math, English, and Reading and to verify that new students have the skills necessary to succeed in courses required for their chosen major. The COMPASS Assessment is free of charge to incoming students, and scores are valid for three years from the date of the original or re-test assessment. The COMPASS Assessment is administered on the computer and takes approximately two hours to complete. After completing the COMPASS Assessment, new students will be assigned an academic advisor who will assist with registration.

Prospective Nursing students are required to take the COMPASS Assessment. For more information contact the Office of Admissions and Records.

#### **Testing Process:**

- 1. Prior to testing, an Application for Admission must be on file in the Admissions Office.
- Visit the Admissions Office Bldg, C (Patterson Campus) or Bldg, F (Trenholm Campus)

Students will receive a handout with assessment information and sample questions. This handout is also available on our Website (under New Student Information--Learning Enhancement Center link). Reviewing this handout will greatly increase your chance of doing your best on the assessment.

- 3. A photo ID will be required before taking the assessment.
- 4. COMPASS results will be provided at the end of each assessment session.
